The Munnabhai is a Bollywood comedy about the troubles of a teenager trying to escape his past. .The deal, which had been scheduled for a vote in the Senate as early as this week, would have significantly increased the size of the government's deficit, but the House of Representatives and Senate are still debating how to pass the deal. "Without this agreement, we face staggering cuts to our national security that will cause a dangerous reduction in readiness," the Air Force chief said. "Our people and their families are counting on us. They need to know that we will meet our obligations to them." "I would like to thank my colleagues in the House for their thoughtful review of this vital agreement," he said. "Despite reservations expressed by some, I am convinced that this agreement will best secure our nation's future, protect our troops, and provide necessary investments in readiness for our nation's Air Force." The cost of the deal would increase the deficit by \$6.2 billion, according to a Congressional Budget Office analysis published last month. The figure is \$1.8 billion more than the deal reached in September, and \$2.5 billion more than the deal reached in August. The Air Force's shortfall was \$7.8 billion in 2013, which marked the last time the U.S. failed to meet a war-funding target. In a statement Monday, House Armed Services Chairman Mac Thornberry (R-Texas) said he is still waiting to hear from the White House about the increase in the deficit. "This agreement raises the deficit by \$6.2 billion and exceeds the budget caps set by the Budget Control Act," he said. "Since we are still waiting to hear the details from the White House about this new agreement, the House will continue to monitor this situation and evaluate the deal's impact on the Defense budget." In a statement to Air Force Times on Monday, House Budget Committee Chairman Paul Ryan (R-Wis.) called the deal "a huge shift in defense priorities." "The sequester spending cuts are already costing our airmen and airwomen, and it would have resulted in a precipitous drop in readiness," he said.
